

Bainbridge: OMSI Science Store

The Oregon Museum of Science and Industry's gift shop will soon be star-studded thanks to a remodel designed by Portland interior design firm Bainbridge.

The OMSI Science Store, which carries hundreds of products related to astronomy, chemistry, robotics and other sciences, will feature a fiber optic night sky in its

telescope section, complete with shooting stars and recognizable constellations. The remodel incorporated the museum's focus on sustainability by using carpet tile made from recycled content and low-energy fluorescent and LED lighting. Existing carpet and store fixtures will be recycled after the remodel. Bainbridge also made custom signs to identify various science fields throughout the store. The remodel is expected to be completed this month by Jaeger & Erwert General Contractors.

The Bainbridge project team included principal Andrea Bainbridge, project manager Jennifer Barker and designers Sermin Yesilada and Kelly Kratochvil. Other consultants on the project included Benya Lighting and Christenson Electric Inc.
